His latest project, ELLA AND FRIENDS: OPERATION OTTER (2025), was released in Finnish cinemas in October 2025. Aleksi is also a founding member of The Alchemist.

## ANSSI KOMULAINEN

Anssi is a media Innovation expert focusing on AI in media. He serves as Director for Data and AI at the Finnish Innovation Fund, which is a future fund with assets of 1 billion euros. Anssi is also a founding member of The Alchemist and a partner in Riviera Cinemas - the coolest cinema startup in Europe. Previous to this, he founded and managed Yle Beta, an incubator for future media with The Finnish Broadcasting Company Yle. Deeply embedded in Europe's startup ecosystem, Anssi is also a trusted advisor to the Future Media Initiative, where he continues to shape the next wave of media innovation.
